



policies.








Culture and Nature

The SASHI Foundation raises the theme of culture and nature for forest conservation practiced by indigenous communities, including religious groups, and the general public through cultural and spiritual values of preservation.

SASHI makes the protection of natural habitats more diverse and sustainable in line with local socio-cultural values. The program works with partners to facilitate the protection of cultural and spiritual values for nature conservation, through the restoration of their rights to their territories as local managers.

Bali Project

Support Social Forestry in Bali



SASHI Foundation in collaboration with Samdhana Institute conducted a study on social forestry management in Bali in achieving community resilience to face climate change. The existence of social forestry is expected to contribute to helping reforestation and in its management can involve GEDSI (Gender Equality, Disability and Social Inclusion). In addition, the results of social forestry will certainly help improve the economy of the managing community.

The number of social forestry in Bali recorded is around 113 which are divided into 5 types, including village forests, forestry partnerships, community forests, community plantation forests, and customary forests. Activities that have been carried out in the period September-January 2022 are analysis and visits to 30 representatives of social forestry in Bali. It was identified that there is a need to increase reforestation in forests in Bali. The role of social forestry managers through tree planting programs is one of the assistance in reforestation efforts. This program has been carried out in all social forestry visited. This is also an effort to overcome the impacts of climate change.

From a gender and social inclusion perspective, almost all women have been involved in managing social forestry. In some social forestry, they have also tried to people with disabilities involve in processing forest products. However, the SASHI Foundation realizes that the community managing social forestry knows and understands enough about gender equality and social inclusion, but there is no in-depth understanding which results in the need for awareness for Gender Equality, Disability and Social Inclusion/GEDSI in fighting for equality, justice and welfare for all levels of society, especially vulnerable and marginalized groups.





The SASHI Foundation has prepared tools/strategies that can be used to monitor the resilience of social forestry management communities in Bali in addressing climate change, including vulnerability indices from Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) and Theory of Change (ToC).

North Kalimantan Project Submission of Social Forestry Proposal for Putat, Seruyung, and Salap Customary Communities in North Malinau District, Malinau Regency




Since mid-2022, the Serasi Alam Santhi Foundation (SASHI) in collaboration with LP3M and the Indigenous Peoples Consultative Forum (FOMMA) and supported by the Nusantara Nature Conservation Foundation (YKAN), has facilitated the Dayak Tahol Indigenous Law Community in Putat, Seruyung, and Salap Villages. This activity aims to get recognition of their customary forest existence.

The SASHI Foundation helped facilitate the process of confirming the customary territory of the Dayak Tahol Tribe in Putat, Seruyung, and Salap Villages to obtain a decree from the Malinau Regent before being submitted to the Ministry of Environment and Forestry to be designated as a Customary Forest.

Additional Program Samdhana Institute and Foker Papua Training Activities



Internship/training activities for Samdhana Institute and Foker LSM Papua staff were held from September 6 to October 14, 2022, guided by the Serasi Alam Santhi Foundation (SASHI). There were 4 interns, 3 from Samdhana Institute and 1 from Foker LSM Papua.

The purpose of this internship is to strengthen the spatial and non-spatial database system in supporting the participatory mapping movement.

The SASHI Foundation provides several materials for internship activities, including geodatabase materials, introduction to the QGIS application, land cover analysis, land cover change, and forest cover, forest loss and forest gain analysis, data management in the QGIS application, and map layout creation.



Interns will learn and practice the materials that have been given and the results of the practice will be presented by each participant to the trainer. The internship activity went well with the hope of being able to provide benefits for the participants and the institutions where the interns are from.
